The year is 1994 in our look back at 30 years of history of the Eureka Community Development Company.

ECDC was a part of a Pilot Program through tourism as one of two communities to implement the Great Places Rural Tourism Development Program.

The board was in contact with several Canadian companies that year, but none materialized in Eureka.

ECDC established an office at the Cal-Cal.

The Heritage Center was a project that was worked on over the span of several years, but never got farther than the planning stages and discussion ceased on it.

Land was purchased for an Information Booth.

Hadleigh Case (a consultant for ECDC) was the speaker at the annual meeting in 1994. New board members elected were Mark Opp and Glenn Opp. Charlene Schrum was hired as the GOLD coordinator for part of the year. Later in the year Sherlock Hirning, a former board member, was appointed to fill the term of a retiring board member.

A Telecommunications Council was formed, consisting of Sherlock Hirning, Walter Dohn, Robert Dockter and an ECDC representative.
